FOGGY BOTTOM GOLF CENTER IS NEWEST ADDITION TO FLATWOODS

The first week of June will bring a long awaited resource for golfers of central West Virginia. Foggy Bottom Golf Center is the newest addition to the variety of amenities offered in Flatwoods, Exit 67 off Interstate 79. Located directly behind the Flatwoods Factory Outlet Stores, Foggy Bottom Golf Center provides a golf driving range with 12 tees, and measures 150 yards wide and 275 yards long. From novice to advanced, golfers of all levels can practice and hone their driving skills, concentrate on adjusting their swing, and attempt to straighten hooks and slices, and improve distance. Equipped with an automatic ball vending machine, the driving range will be open seven days a week from dusk to dawn. Buckets of golf balls can be purchased in an assortment of sizes with prices starting as low as \$5.00 a bucket.

“West Virginia is blessed with many great golf courses, and we feel that our driving range with its central location will allow golfers to improve their skills when they don’t have the time to play 18 holes,” states Greg Skidmore, Chief Operational Officer of John Skidmore Development Inc., owner of Foggy Bottom Golf Center. “We have plans in the future to develop the area surrounding the driving range to include additional sports associated facilities that will be family fun oriented and help develop the athletic skills of adults and youth.” The earliest plans include a putting green adjacent to the driving range to create a comprehensive golf practice facility.

Staff is busy completing the final touches in preparation for the early-June opening of the driving range. A Grand will be coming later this summer, with competitions and prize giveaways occurring throughout the day.

Foggy Bottom Golf Center is a complementary addition to the already unique variety of amenities found in Flatwoods, and is conveniently located near the hub of the recreation and business district. Travelers at the KOA campground can pull their clubs from the camper for an afternoon of practice. Prior to concerts at the Mountain Lakes Amphitheater, fans can tee off a few buckets of balls.
